The changing climate, the biting winds, central heating and open fires that dry us out, lack of vitamin D and external pollution can all lead to dry, dehydrated and parched skin. After the summer months, our skin may also be suffering from the ravages of UV rays, such as hyperpigmentation, sun-spots and more lines and wrinkles than we'd care to see when we glance in the mirror.

Dermal Peels

Dermal peels are fantastic for revealing fresh clear and youthful looking skin and what's great about undergoing a course of peels in winter is that there is less risk of UV damage afterwards.

Dermal peels comprise of specifically chosen fruit or sugar-derived acids, which are applied to the skin for a measured amount of time. Once the acids have completed their action of chemically exfoliating dead skin cells, dirt, debris and pigmentation, they are neutralized by a special substance.

The skin is then cleansed and moisturised, leaving a fresh, glowing appearance. There is no clinical downtime and you can return to your daily activities after a peel, as long as you follow the aftercare advice, given to you by your Mirabel practitioner.









When will I see the results?

Depending on your skin concerns and their severity, the results from dermal peels can be seen in as little as one treatment. However, for most skin concerns, we would recommend a course of three treatments, in order to obtain the most significant and lasting results. You will be able to explain to your practitioner, what bothers you about your skin and the results you are hoping to achieve, in your initial consultation.



IPL for skin rejuvenation

IPL utilises specific wavelengths of light, flashed on to the skin using an IPL device, for the treatment of various skin conditions such as ageing and sun damage. It feels a little like a rubber band, snapping against the skin and a number of treatments is usually required, to achieve satisfactory results.



Goggles are worn to protect your eyes and you may feel a little sting or hot sensation as the device head is passed across your skin and the flashes of light are emitted. There is not usually a necessity for the application of numbing cream and this can impair the results, but if you are particularly sensitive, you can request pre-treatment anaesthetic cream.

There is no clinical downtime afterwards, though you may experience some redness or swelling and occasional blistering in the treatment area. As with all laser treatments, there is a small risk of burning or pigmentation changes within the skin.

When will I see the results?

Initial results can be achieved after the first session with IPL, however, we do recommend a course of treatment, depending on your skin condition and its severity. Top up sessions may be required every few months to maintain your results, again, depending on the skin concern.





Sclerotherapy

Sclerotherapy is the gold standard for the removal of thread veins; those tiny dilated blood vessels found just underneath the skin's surface, found mostly on areas of the body such as the legs.

If you are someone who has very visible thread veins, you will understand how annoying they can be. Sclerotherapy is a superb treatment to have in the colder months, as, following treatment there can be some significant bruising and you will need to wear compression socks for a period of time advised by the practitioner; so it's easier to conceal a post-thread vein treatment at a time of year when you are naturally covering up more.







The number of treatments you will need will depend on how many thread veins are present. However, most patients undergo 1 to 2 treatments, each lasting around 60 minutes. This treatment is not painful, as the needles which are used to make the injections are extremely fine. You might feel an itchy sensation immediately afterwards and some slight tenderness in the treatment area for a day or two. If necessary, an anti-inflammatory cream can be used, to ease these symptoms. You may also notice some tiny blisters which form on the skin after the treatment, which then scab over like a tiny sore, before healing completely. Bruising however can be quite significant.

Therefore, having this treatment in the winter months, but giving enough time for bruising to subside before wearing that 'little black dress' should be considered.

When will I see the results?

Thread veins which are treated with sclerotherapy are permanently removed and the results can be seen almost immediately. However, sometimes a course of treatment is recommended for optimum removal of the thread veins. It is worth considering that this is not a treatment that can prevent further thread veins forming. However, at Mirabel Clinic we can offer you expert advice on how you can make some simple lifestyle changes, so that you can prevent further thread veins from appearing.

The Mirabel Skin Brightening Treatment

After the summer months, the skin can seem dry and less bright. The build-up of pigmentation from the sun's rays, as well as dehydration of the skin, can all lead to a duller tone and texture.

At Mirabel Clinic we offer a range of treatment packages to suit all skin concerns. Our brightening treatment combines IPL Skin Rejuvenation and Profhilo* injections to brighten and hydrate the skin, to become more resilient to the winter months ahead.

IPL

IPL utilises specific wavelengths of light energy, flashed on to the skin, to promote collagen production, fade hyperpigmentation and increase cell turnover within the skin.

Profhilo°

Profhilo^{*} is an injectable, hyaluronic acid (HA) skin bio-remodelling substance, which, over the course of 2 treatments helps to restore lost volume within the skin tissues and to intensely hydrate and plump the skin.

When will I see the results?

The 2 treatments act synergistically over the course of a few months, resulting in younger looking skin and an age defying luminescence, which cannot be achieved by either of the individual treatments alone. The course includes 5 treatment sessions, carried out over 2 months. 3 IPL treatments and 2 Profhilo* procedures. A saving of £250 is achieved when booking for the complete brightening package, compared to the individual ones.



SkinPen®

Winter can be a great time for specific treatments where avoiding the sun in the days following treatment is advised. SkinPen* medical microneedling is one of these procedures and can solve a myriad of skin issues in around 3 treatment sessions.

Skin Pen[®] is often referred to as medical microneedling or CIT (Collagen Induction Therapy). It works by promoting the naturally increased collagen production in ageing skin, without scarring; healing to promote brighter, firmer and smoother looking skin.

SkinPen* helps to reduce the appearance of ageing, such as lines, wrinkles, sun-damage, dehydration and conditions such as acne scars and trauma scars.









It works by utilising 14 state of the art, smooth, adjustable length needles, which pierce the skin and cause thousands of tiny injuries. The body responds by producing collagen in order to heal the damage, resulting in a more resilient, glowing skin, with a more even tone and texture.



The downtime is minimal and usually consists of a slightly red appearance in the treated areas, similar to moderate sunburn. This is why SkinPen* is a good treatment to have in the months when the sun is not at its strongest.



When will I see the results?

For the best results, we recommend a course of 3 or more treatments, a month apart, depending on your individual skin requirements. Optimum results can be seen following the full course, suggested by your practitioner.

Injectables have long been the mainstay of any reputable aesthetic medical clinic, as they can treat a variety of skin and facial concerns.



Botox® (anti-wrinkle injections), dermal fillers and skin boosters and re-modellers such as BELOTERO® Revive and Profhilo® all act in their own ways to either reduce the appearance of wrinkles, re-shape facial features, rehydrate the skin and help the dermis to repair itself on a cellular level.



Botox* is arguably the most famous injectable. It is a neurotoxin called Botulinum Toxin Type A which temporarily blocks the nerve signals to the muscles of the face which can succumb to expression lines.

At Mirabel we use three different toxins, depending on your individual requirement and the judgement of the practitioner. When expertly injected in to the specific upper face areas, toxins smooth out the lines and wrinkles which are caused when we create facial expressions. Lines such as forehead lines, Glabellar lines, crow's feet and dropped eyebrows can all be corrected for up to 6 months.

When will I see the results?

Results can be seen from 48 hours to 2weeks, following your treatment.

Dermal fillers are the most versatile of all the injectable substances.


Comprised of Hyaluronic Acid (HA) they come in a range of viscosities and offer a myriad of facial benefits, from filling lines, wrinkles and deeper folds and facial hollows to re-shaping and re-modelling facial features.

When will I see the results?

Results can be seen immediately, however, you will possibly need to allow time for any bruising or swelling to subside and in some cases, the product to settle and integrate within the skin tissues.







Profhilo* is the first BDDE-free stabilised injectable hyaluronic acid (HA) based product which treats skin laxity and dehydration.

It contains one of the highest concentrations of HA on the market (64mg/2ml) and not only boosts the hydration of the skin, but also remodels ageing and sagging skin tissue.

When will I see the results?

Some results can be seen 4 weeks after the first treatment, however, best results are achieved in a course of 2 treatments, with 6 monthly top-up treatments advised for maintenance.



BELOTERO® Revive


